Call for Papers

The Catholic Record Society is delighted to announce a call for papers for its 61st annual conference, to be held at Murray Edwards College, Cambridge, 23–25 July 2018. The Society invites proposals on any topic relating to Reformation and post-Reformation Catholic History in the British Isles. We welcome proposals for papers of no more than 2000 words. Each speaker is allocated 20 minutes, including discussion.

The Society offers up to five bursaries to registered postgraduate students who wish to offer a short paper. If a paper is proposed by a postgraduate student, and is accepted, the speaker will automatically be considered for a bursary. The value of the bursary is equivalent to half of the cost of attending the conference (excluding travel costs).

To propose a paper, please fill in the enclosed application form, including an abstract of 300 words, and submit online no later than **Friday 8 June 2018**. All proposals are considered by the CRS Council, and applicants are informed of acceptance by email as soon as possible.
